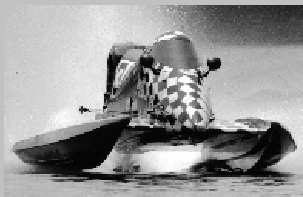

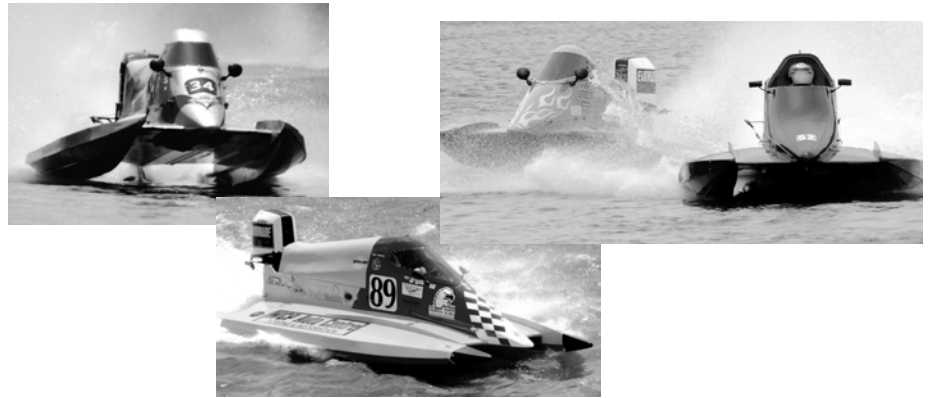

APBA sanctioned and insured test session and capsule training



The possibility of a late spring test session was discussed during the October 15, 2010 meeting in Cartersville, Georgia. At that time Superleague was looking for a safety capsule for training and the thought was to combine the APBA required capsule training and a stand alone test session that would be sanctioned and insured – a definite must for driver safety. We are pleased that after the meeting, Dana Tomes (#75, Herd Racing) came to us and offered his assistance in the transformation of an old boat into a usable safety-training unit. Now, with the help of Dana, the Herd Race Team, Howie Nichols, Sam Haraway, Lee Bias and Tim Calhoun, Superleague has a training capsule that is permanently available.

After exploring possible venues and working on a reasonable budget, we are pleased to announce a capsule training and test session on Sunday (1 day only), May 8, at Buckeye Lake in Ohio. Capsule training will take place from 9:30 AM to 11:30 AM in the pool at the Best Western hotel in Hebron, Ohio and the test session will start at noon on the lake at Liebs Island. Details are included – everything you need to know to go.



Crank It Up

LOCATION: Buckeye Lake State Park, OH, just off of I-70, at the Lieb's Island ramp area with plenty of paved parking and restroom facilities.

DIRECTIONS: Note that there are two park areas at Buckeye Lake – we are using the Lieb's Island location. From I-70 (east or west) take exit 129 A toward Buckeye Lake. Turn right at the end of the exit, slight right (road curves) at Park Ave./Walnut St. Follow road through Buckeye Lake community, turn left at Tanner; turn right at N. Bank and follow road to parking lot and ramp area (on your left). The park is approximately 30 miles east of Columbus, Ohio.

DATE: Sunday, one day only, May 8, 2011



CLASSES: Capsule training is open to everyone. Testing is primarily geared to OPC classes – SST45, SST 60 and SST 120. If there is enough interest from the Stock, Mod, Pro and Inboard categories, additional classes

and times will be added. Call the Superleague office (304 455-2049) for current status of your class. **You must be a member of APBA (you can join during the training/test sessions) but you do not need to be a member of Powerboat Superleague.**

SCHEDULE: Sunday 9:30 AM – 11:30 AM – capsule training at the Best Western Lakewood Hotel (see hotel info for directions)

Sunday noon – 4 PM test sessions, division of time will depend on classes and teams registered. Separate race courses will be set for each class.

Cost

Test Session – with or without capsule training: In order to cover the cost of the park usage fee, sanction and insurance fees, as well as the cost of APBA certified rescue, an ambulance and officials, we need to charge **\$200 per driver** if we have 14 registrations. (Our total cost = \$2785). If more than 14 drivers register, then we will reduce the cost. 10 –13 teams registered, the cost will be \$275 per team and less than 10 teams, the test session will be cancelled. **Registration must be paid on or before April 29.**

Capsule Training Only: \$25/driver

How to Register

To register for either the training or the testing or both, print out the APBA entry form at the end of this Gazette. Fill it out and mail or fax to the Superleague office. Alternately, you can indicate that you are planning to attend via email, be sure to include your APBA # and class/boat # to samwiner3@gmail.com.
